Tax to be claimed by the UFRC:

The **UFRC** will reclaim 28p of tax on every £1 you gave up to 5 April 2008.

The **Government will pay to the UFRC** an additional 3p on every £1 you give between 6 April 2008 and 5 April 2011. This transitional relief does not affect your personal tax position.
