In 2017 UFRC began an initiative to try and encourage clubs to reach out to new members. In total 12 clubs participated with almost 100 new walkers coming forward. We encourage clubs to consider adding an invitation walk or event to encourage new members.

What do you need to do now?

- Any club can add an event. This can be anything from an upland walk to a gentle stroll. An existing walk in the club programme may be just as suitable as a new walk.
- Decide on a route. If you have a space in your programme be true to your club's traditional walks. Remember that the people are looking to join a club not just go for a walk.
- Decide on the number of places. The event can be open to as many or as few people as your club would like but 10 to 15 places is an ideal number.
